Emergency road rehabilitation in rural clusters commences

Umdoni municipality has taken a vigorous approach to its rural road maintenance plan by beefing up resources to give due diligence to the emergency rehabilitation work to be conducted on rural roads that were severely damaged during the recent heavy rains.

Subsequent to a comprehensive assessment conducted by municipal engineers in liaison with ward councillors, it was resolved that two roads per ward in Clusters 1,2,3 and 4 will undergo a 20-day rehabilitation programme.

The municipality has appointed four

service providers, one per cluster and each service provider was mandated to provide two 10-ton tipper trucks, one water tanker, one roller, one grader and one excavator as part of the service contract

To officially mark the commencement of this emergency rehabilitation project, the Mayor, Cllr Mbali Cele-Luthuli, the Deputy Mayor, Cllr Phila Thabethe and Ward 7 Councillor, Sthembiso Mthwane received the hired plant at Malangeni MPPC on Tuesday that will be utilised as additional resources to conduct regravelling and blading of the identified roads in the different clusters.

Work in the other Clusters has also commenced and all rehabilitation work is scheduled to be completed by end of April 2025.

The Mayor, Cllr Mbali Cele-Luthuli said that it was imperative for Umdoni to fast-track the commencement of the emergency rehabilitation of rural roads because thousands of communities that use these roads daily are suffering and also their current state poses an enormous danger to motorists. "During the budget adjustment period, Council approved that a provision be made in the budget to aid the emergency rehabilitation work. "The

safety of our communities is a priority to us as leaders and we cannot turn a blind eye to the inconvenience these rains have caused to them. We needed to act with compassion, put ourselves in their shoes and ensure we prioritise the communities' safety," said the Mayor. The current emergency work being conducted is an additional responsibility to the municipality outside the Council approved rural road rehabilitation programme that is currently ongoing which includes routine maintenance and construction of 50-meter steep hills amongst other work.

Roads upgrade bring delight to communities

Umdoni municipality is fulfilling the commitment made to the Amahlongwa and Malangeni communities to upgrade Mafithini Road in Ward 9 and Nsongeni Road in Ward 16 for convenient travelling for the everyday users of these roads.

These projects are progressing well with Mafithini Road sitting at a 60% completion rate and Nsongeni Road at a 37% completion rate. The projects entail the upgrade of 1.6 kilometres by 6 metres and 1.8 kilometres by 6 metres of Mafithini and Nsongeni Roads respectively from gravel to asphalt. Other work to be conducted on both roads include installation of a concrete drainage system, speed humps, rumble strips, gabions and road furniture plus a side walk for Nsongeni Road. Work currently in progress on Mafithini Road includes the processing of C3 and G2 layer, installation of gabions and kerbs. On Nsongeni Road, the processing of gravel material and installation of storm water pipes and gabions are underway.

Both these projects are scheduled to take a period of 8 months to be completed ending

in June 2025. "I am pleased that Umdoni is delivering services as promised to the communities it serves. As this Council we are pleased to witness service delivery projects outlined in the municipal Integrated Development Plan being implemented. Our communities are being developed and we are confident that we will reach the goal of a better life for all," said the Mayor, Cllr Mbali Cele-Luthuli.

And towards ensuring that Umdoni makes a significant contribution to impoverished communities, the municipality has ensured that the appointed contractors for the projects give job opportunities to people from the areas where projects are being implemented. Under the Mafithini Road project, eleven people have benefited with temporary employment and for the Nsongeni Road project, 19 people have been employed. "Our priority as government is to triumph over the triple challenge of poverty, unemployment and inequality and that is why Umdoni insists on ensuring that local people benefit from projects being undertaken in their wards."

Municipality maintains urban roads and storm water drains

Umdoni continues to work towards the preservation of the municipality's road infrastructure to ensure its sustainability and increase its life span. Recently, the municipality implemented its road and storm water maintenance programme in the urban areas.

The municipality's road maintenance plan aims to ensure that the roads are reliable and safe for road users. In 2022, the municipality conducted a conditional assessment of its road network where a need was identified to conduct a thorough rehabilitation of roads and maintenance of storm water in order to ensure the Umdoni is kept in a good condition and continues to attract tourists and investments.

The municipality made an allocation of R10 Million for urban road rehabilitation and recycling. The work being conducted includes recycling, stabilization, processing of G2 material and laying of

To date, the municipality rehabilitated 910 meters of Court Road in Ward 13 which has been successfully completed, 200 meters of Gardner Street in Ward 10 is at a 70% completion rate, 300 meters of Erskiene Road in Ward 15 is 98% towards completion, 300 meters of Preston Road in Ward 10 has been completed, 400 meters of Azalea Crescent in War 11 is 80% complete and 325 meters of Pertunia Road in Ward 12 is currently at a 50% completion rate. Over and above the road rehabilitation projects, the municipality is concurrently conducting pothole patching in various

Moreover, additional emphasis has been placed in the operations of the storm water drainage systems. The municipality has cleaned storm water drains in Ward 15, 10,12 and 13 to ensure proper channeling of storm water and maximize safety for road users during heavy rains.

Ngokwesabelomali esasiphasisiwe ukufeza lomsebenzi wentuthuko, umasipala uzosebenzisa imali eyiZigidi eziyisiShiyagalombili nengxenye (R8.5 Million) ukuxhuma ugesi kwimizi engama 269 isiyonke, eyakhiwa engama 68 e-Kiss-Kiss kanye nengama 201 e-Mbetheni. Osekuqediwe kulephrojekthi, ukufakwa kwezigxobo zikagesi kanye nokufakwa kwezintambo ezihambisa ugesi. Okusenziwa njengamanje ukuqinisekisa ukufakwa nokuxhunywa kwazo zonke izimfanelo ezidingekayo ukuze ugesi ukwazi ukusebenza ngendlela uma sekufike isikhathi sokuwukhanvisa. Njengamanje, lephrojekthi isifinyelele kumaphesenti angamaShumi ayisiShiyaqalolunge (90%). Umphakathi uyakhunjuziswa ukuthi lesibalo semizi eyi 154 esele

engakaxhunyelwa ugesi kulonyaka wezimali ka2024/25, nayo isohlelweni kunyaka wezimali omusha ka 2025/26. "Umasipala wasifaka isicelo soxhaso lwemali kuMnyango Wezokumbiwa Namandla sonyaka wezimali ka2025/26 ukuze umasipala uxhumele lemizi esele njengokuthembisa kobuholi ngenkathi umasipala uzophendula isoyi kulendawo," kusho iMeya uKhansela Mbali Cele-Luthuli.

IMeya iphinde yaveza ukuthi umasipala uyazibophezela ukuqinisekisa ukuthi yonke imizi ebihlelelwe kulephrojekthi angeke isale ngaphandle Umasipala usebenza ngokuzikhandla ukuqinisekisa ukuthi intuthuko yokuxhunywa kukagesi ezindawen zasemakhaya ezingenawo iyafika kuyona yonke imiphakathi yasemakhaya engaphansi koMdoni. Ukufakwa kukagesi kuhlose nokunganda isimo sokubhebhetheka kwezinyokanyoka. "Siyayigqugquzela yonke imiphakathi ukuthi ikukhuthalele ukukhokhela ugesi nokuwuthenga ngoba ukuxhunywa kukagesi ngokungekho emthethweni kulimaza uhulumeni kanye nalabo abawuthengayo nabawukhokhelayo,' kusho iMeya.

Umdoni offers much-needed help to victims of heavy rains


The leadership of Umdoni was available with help when needed the most by families whose homes were damaged and lost essentials during the recent heavy rains. The Mayor, Cllr Mbali Cele-Luthuli led a delegation of Councillors to visit the identified affected families and also physically assess the level of damage to infrastructure. The Disaster Management Services reported 287 households were affected, two fatalities due to drowning, displacement of five families, six destroyed and 66 partially destroyed households and over 200 roads combined have been affected in both the rural and urban areas.

According to the Mayor, the purpose of the visits and assessments by Councillors was to have a vivid picture of the damage on the ground in order for the leadership to make well-informed decisions on actions to be taken that directly respond to the witnessed damages. The Mayor and various Councillors visited families in wards 4 and 17

and assisted with essential needs. Displaced families were assisted with temporary housing units for dignified shelter while longterm solutions are being put in place. All major incidents were duly escalated to the departments of housing, transport, social development and provincial disaster management services for intervention. The municipality has assisted with blankets, plastic sheeting, sleeping mattresses and other essentials to assist affected families. "We have witnessed the damage made by these rains and we will remain close to the affected families to ensure they are assisted and their lives return to normality as soon as possible with the assistance of relevant departments," said the Mayor.
